

SAFETY RULES

Follow our **Safety rules** to keep our airport safe, compliant and efficient.

Airside Traffic

Driving within the airside area involves...

► Without Airside Driving Permit (ADP)

- Mandatory escort;
- Strictly following escorting vehicle or the guidance given by the person escorting.

► With Airside Driving Permit (ADP)

Strictly following driving rules.



Cigarettes / vap and other substances

- **Smoking allowed only in the dedicated areas:**
- **Prohibition** on being under the influence of **drugs, alcohol or medication.**



Mandatory equipment to be worn airside

- Visibility jacket / vest;
- Personal Protective Equipment.

Fuelling & Fire hazards

Only **ATEX** electronic devices are to be used:

- In the area identified as ATEX;
- In the close vicinity of a fuel truck or aircraft being refuelled /approx.. 3,5 m radius).



No open fires nor works creating sparks are allowed without authorisation.

How to manage FOD - Foreign Object Debris?



Any objects or loose items found on the Airside area should be **picked up and disposed in a FOD bin.**

Remove FOD is everybody's responsibility at the airport.

ENVIRONMENT

Follow our **Green Rules** to help protect the environment.



Provide your teams with anti-pollution kits.



Do not voluntarily dump liquids or materials in the drainage.



Avoid Dangerous Goods storage.



Turn off the engine of unused equipment.



Burn nothing on site.



Sort your waste for recycling.



What to do in case of...

Accident, incident or hazardous situations



When calling the LACC, you have to:

- Mention your location precisely;
- Describe the event;
- State the number of victims and - where applicable - their consciousness status.

Fire alarm and evacuation

► Fire detected

1. Press the fire button or inform LACC;
2. Try to extinguish without putting yourself at risk;
3. Inform LACC of result;
4. Follow instructions of LACC / Fire Department.



► Evacuation : when you hear evacuation messages

1. Evacuate immediately and close doors and windows if any;
2. Follow evacuation signs;
NB: If there is a lot of smoke accumulating on the ceiling, get out by bending or crawling, covering your mouth and nose as best you can.
3. Reach an assembly point and remain there until further instructions.

RULES OF CIRCULATION & ACCESS

How to access to airport facilities



► As a person

Wearing clearly visible:

- Your airport identification card;
- Or your crew card;
- Or your daily visitor's badge, in addition to the accompaniment of an authorized person.

► As a vehicle

Needing a security access card which has to be visible, from the outside.
